This is a complaint and notification to the Attorney General and the following parties involved or concerned. It is sphere headed by Hood Researchers; Carl Williams, Hassan Aleem, Percy Harris, and Reggie Crawford Co-Founders & Theo Broughton candidate for the Detroit third District School Board, Mayoral Candidate, Sharon McPhail, Senator Martha G. Scott, Council Candidates; Barbara Rose Collins, Joann Watson, Maryann Mahaffey, and Kwame Kenyatta

The petitions by the Michigan Civil Right Initiative Committee to have Affirmative Action placed on the ballot in the next election are not in compliance with the law.

We have reviewed the petitions in Lansing on Friday, July 22, 2005 and none of the petitions were notarized. Therefore, the prima facie evidence of the signature genuineness to comply with Section 1 Art 5 of the Constitution is questionable and without the Constitutional affidavit attached to the section of the petition it can have no validity. See Thompson v. Secretary of State 192 Mich Reports 512 and also see the decision of the Detroit City Clerk in the Community Coalition v Dennis Archer.

We are also requesting an opinion from the Attorney General on this matter.
